

## Two days workshop on Couple Therapy in the Chinese context

### About the workshop

It is not common for Chinese couples and families to seek for professional support to solve relational conflicts, while such issues can be difficult and complex to manage. Asian Professional Counselling Association (APCA) invited **Ms. WONG Lai Cheung**, an experienced marriage and family therapist to shares her valuable experiences on working with couples in local context. Important knowledge and techniques to be included in couple therapy sessions will be covered.

#### *Content*

- Use of systemic and emotion-focused approach in couple therapy;
- Contracting relational goals with couple;
- Understanding the dynamics of couple relationships;
- A framework of couple counselling;
- Interviewing skills;
- Sharing of local experiences;

Various kinds of activities will be included, such as Lectures, Role plays and Exercises.

**Ms. WONG Lai Cheung**, a private practitioner in counselling and training, specializes in marriage and family therapy. After graduation from the Chinese University of Hong Kong and University of Hong Kong respectively, Ms. Wong has furthered her training in marriage and family therapy in the United States. She is also an accredited family mediator and family mediation supervisor of the Hong Kong International Arbitration Centre.

Ms. Wong has a theological training from the University of Edinburgh and is currently a PhD. candidate at the University of Hong Kong. Apart from direct practice, Ms Wong also teaches in universities and has numerous publications in marriage and emotions. Ms Wong has plentiful experiences in conducting training to social workers, clergymen and teachers.
