

Understanding the House-Tree-Person Test (Part 1)

The House-Tree-Person Test

The House Tree Person Test (HTP), a projective personality test, was developed in 1948, and updated in 1969. In the HTP, the test taker is asked to draw houses, trees, and persons in the belief that these drawings provide a certain measure of self-perceptions and attitudes. Over the years, several innovative variations have been introduced to further enrich the HTP.

The HTP is scored in both an objective quantitative mode and a subjective qualitative mode. The quantitative scoring scheme involves analyzing the details of drawings to derive a general assessment of intelligence. However, the primary use of the HTP is related to the qualitative scoring scheme in which the test administrator subjectively interprets the test-takers' drawings and responses to questions. Since the qualitative scoring is largely subjective, scoring and interpreting the HTP is difficult and administrators of the HTP should be properly trained.

In this one-day workshop, the focus will be placed upon qualitative scoring. The variations mentioned above will also be introduced. Quantitative scoring will be introduced in part 2 of HTP workshop to be held in late 2011, this course will be the pre-requisite of the H-T-P advanced course.

Presenter

Professor Catherine Sun is currently head of the Department of Counselling and Psychology at Hong Kong Shue Yan University. She is also President of the Asian Professional Counselling Association (APCA). Professor Sun wrote "Drawing as a Projective Technique" (《畫圖測心理》·香港:明窗出版社) in 1992. Over the years, she has collected hundreds of HTP drawings which she will selectively share during the workshop.
