Understanding the House Tree Person Test (HTP) Advanced Course

The House Tree Person Test (HTP), a projective personality test, was developed in 1948, and updated in 1969. Over the years, the development of the HTP has generated different scoring systems for assessment purpose, which in turns enriches case conceptualization, and informs treatment. Empirical research has demonstrated that with proper interpretation, the test takers' drawings can be a reliable measure that reflects self-perception and attitude.

The interpretation of HTP can be done qualitatively and quantitatively. In most situations, the qualitative interpretation of HTP is conducted subjectively by the test administrator who has received proper training. However, the interpretation can also be conducted in conjunction with the HTP test-kit to render more comprehensive understanding of the person being tested.

Overall, the HTP test-kit guides both experienced and inexperienced test administrators to interpret a broad spectrum of aspects of the test taker's drawings. The data so derived provides information on the test taker's personality traits and state of mind, and allows intrasubject and intersubject comparisons. Thus, by using the HTP test-kit in the administration and interpretation processes, relevant and valuable information may be gleaned for the purpose of clinical report writing and treatment planning.

In this advanced workshop, participants will be systematically trained in using the HTP test kit and prepare a report on test taker's personality traits and state of mind based on the data obtained. The report will also inform counsellors on the best possible approach to use with clients.

Speaker

Professor **Catherine Sun** is currently head of the Department of Counselling and

Psychology at Hong Kong Shue Yan University. She is also President of the Asian Professional Counselling Association (APCA). Professor Sun wrote *Drawing as a Projective Technique* (《畫圖測心理》, 香港: 明窗出版社) in 1992. Over the years, she has collected hundreds of HTP drawings which she will selectively share during the workshop
