Art therapy is a therapeutic counseling and psychotherapy approach to help clients with verbal and non-verbal self-exploration so as to discover their inner worlds. Based on Jungian psychoanalyses, the art therapist encourages client to express their emotion, feeling, imagination/fantasy in art therapy by working on the creative process spontaneously, such as drawing, sculpturing, sand play, collage., etc.

The purpose of the workshop is to provide members an art therapy experience to increase self-awareness and understand the creatively therapeutic process. You will learn:

1. The naturally feeling and emotional expression through working on art/drawing.
2. To open mind to understand and accept personal opinion, feeling and emotion with different styles of expression.
